Completed projects and accomplishments (include purchases):

We engage in a variety of activities throughout the year to help grow relationships, deepen Christian faith and understanding, and build the size of our membership and overall impact of our church. We have monthly activities, annual activities, and special events. Monthly activities include Communion Sunday Fellowship (up to \$200 in donations depending on the menu); 1st Wednesday meetings at 5:30pm via Zoom; and monthly birthday luncheon celebrations (self-pay lunch and \$25-\$50 in donations used for expenses such as room reservations, decorations, cupcakes, and/or favors). Sister Katherine Samuels handles greeting card outreach with additional assistance this particular year from Sister Otero Tinker—for birthdays, sickness, and mourning (approximately \$10 monthly for cards with stamps provided by the church). Annual events include Pancake Tuesday which precedes Lent Wednesday, Mother's Day Hat Parade and Mother's Day recognition booklet; and Women's Day Service during which \$5,625 was raised. Women in White was not held during April given the number of activities also taking place to welcome and install Pastor Mark Wainwright. Special activities include a group movie viewing of the Color Purple (self-pay with group discount), supporting Winter Relief. (approximately \$100 donation in food for dinner); and, set-up and take down of Christmas decorations preceding Candlelight Service.

A subcommittee led by Sister Nancy Williams is developing a Women's Ministry Brochure

We are seeking approval to convene a Women's Ministry Spring Retreat—Saturday, April 26th, 9am to noon, FBC Annex, and ideally use the same guest speaker for Women's Day
